MEDICAL / DENTAL LOANS	Your Employees' Association can provide an interest-free, no cost, automatically payroll deducted loan for medical and dental procedures not covered by your health plan.
DEATH-IN-FAMILY LOANS	The death of an immediate family member can be devastating, but our staff will assist you in applying for an interest-free, no cost loan, automatically payroll deducted to cover funeral related expenses.
EMERGENCY LOANS	Emergencies seem to occur when we least expect them. If you are affected by an unforeseen financial hardship, we also have automatically payroll deducted interest-free, no cost emergency loans.
SAFETY SHOE LOANS & EQUIPMENT	Do you need safety shoes for your job? Your Employees' Association can provide an interest-free, no cost, automatically payroll deducted loan. Visit one of our approved vendors. Forms are available from the safety shoe vendor.

Who can apply for assistance?

All active employees on the Department payroll who have completed probation, or any LADWP retiree

How is a loan repaid?

Two and a half years, or sixty consecutive pay periods, following death-in-family and dental/medical loans advances ~ Three consecutive pay periods following emergency loans or safety shoe and equipment purchases

What types of requests will be considered?

Transportation or housing bills caused by an emergency ~ Non-covered dental or health expenses ~ Death-in-family funeral expenses

What type of documentation is needed to process an application?

Easy qualification process with NO CREDIT CHECKS! • Submit a completed loan application, a past due bill, medical/dental bill, written estimate from repair shop or other creditor information ~ Acceptable proof of the obligation or need ~ Copies of your two most recent pay stubs

When are loan applications due?

No later than Friday at 3:00 p.m. to be reviewed on the following Tuesday ~ Certain emergency requests are reviewed and approved in 24 hours or less

Who are checks made payable to?

Loan checks can be made payable <u>only</u> to the creditor, business or institution

Who is eligible to run for office?

All active, permanent Los Angeles Department of Water & Power employees with at least one (1) full year of service, or more than six (6) months employment with DWP plus one year of service with the City of Los Angeles; provided the service was immediately preceding LADWP employment.

What is the term of office?

Standard terms are three years and begin on July 1. Sometimes there are vacant positions with less than three years remaining on the term. If a System has two vacant positions, one full term and one partial term position, the person receiving the most votes will fill the longer term.

How can I become a candidate?

- 1. Verify at the bottom of this page that a board director vacancy exists in the System in which you are employed.
- 2. Remove the facing page. Complete the petition and candidate statement on the reverse side. Please note that the petition requests the signatures of twenty (20) Department employees that work within your System, along with approval from your Supervisor, and Business Unit Director. 

DONORS' WELFARE PLAN



Ettie Lee Youth & Family Services, started more than 60 years ago, and has helped hundreds of children, youth and families throughout the past year. Our residential services specialize in youth who have severe emotional/behavioral problems and/or academic failure. We serve just about 80 children throughout our network of more than 30 foster care adoption families. We also reach out to the community with mental health and substance use disorder programs.

One family that really succeeded this year is single mom Alexandra and her 5 kids (1 girl and 4 boys) who are on their way to rebuilding their lives. It all seemed to fall apart two years ago, when one of the kids was molested by their grandfather with whom they lived. The kids were taken out of their home and for a few months placed in different foster homes. Ettie Lee Youth & Family Services, however, was called in because we were able to place all of the children together - in one home where Alexandra visited often. That really gave the kids peace of mind as Alexandra found employment and a new home for all of them. Just before Thanksgiving the family was together once again - in their own home! Ettie Lee will continue to be in their lives providing Alexandra and her family with therapeutic services as long as they are needed. Our thanks to the LADWP Employees' for donating to the Donors' Welfare Plan and helping families just like Alexandra's and so many more!



BROWNIE RUBBLE



INGREDIENTS

- 2 sticks plus 2 tablespoons unsalted butter, plus more for the pan
- 1 cup all-purpose flour, plus more for dusting
- 6 ounces bittersweet chocolate, chopped
- 2 cups sugar
- 3/4 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 large eggs, cold
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 cup mini marshmallows
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 3/4 cup unsalted roasted peanuts

DIRECTIONS

Line an 8-inch-square baking pan with foil, pressing it into the corners and up the sides; leave an overhang on 2 sides. Butter the foil and dust with flour. Position a rack in the lower third of the oven; preheat to 400 degrees F.

Bring 1 inch water to a gentle simmer in a medium saucepan over medium-low heat. Put the chocolate and 2 sticks plus 2 tablespoons butter in a heatproof bowl; set the bowl over the saucepan (do not let the bowl touch the water). Stir occasionally until melted and smooth. Remove the bowl from the saucepan.

Add the sugar, cocoa and salt to the bowl and stir vigorously with a wooden spoon until smooth. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well between each addition, until the batter is thick and shiny. Add the vanilla, then add 1 cup flour and mix until combined. Spread in the prepared pan.

Bake the brownies until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out with just a few crumbs, about 35 minutes. Remove from the oven and scatter the marshmallows, chocolate chips and peanuts on top. Return to the oven; continue baking until the marshmallows are golden, about 5 more minutes.

Let cool in the pan on a rack, 30 minutes. Lift the brownies out of the pan using the foil and transfer to a cutting board to cool completely before slicing.
