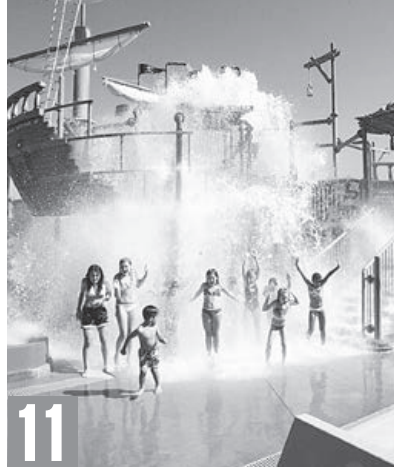

The good news is that the establishment of the Donors' Welfare Campaign supported by LADWP management has really made a difference in bringing attention to the various Donors' Fund supported programs to the majority of our workforce and significantly increased contributions to the Donors' Fund. The enthusiastic participation of the General Manager (Thanks, Marcie!) and the Senior Management Team ensured that these efforts would be successful. It didn't hurt to add an element of competition to the process and a nice big trophy to go along with bragging rights!

With Division and section coordinators acting as liaison and head cheerleader for their coworkers, information was disseminated, questions answered and even interest in serving as a Board Director was aroused. Our members stepped up tremendously! One time donations and payroll deduction commitments increased annual contributions over the \$100,000 initial goal of the first campaign and exceeded that amount in the second year.

My greatest satisfaction is that the Campaign proved what I have always believed: that the value of the Association lies in its programs and services to employees, active and retired, as well as their families. The Campaign response shows that it is truly a shared value held by each and every member that gives whatever they can to ensure that these benefits will continue into the future.

As I look forward to another year of projects and planning, I encourage members to take an interest in the Association. Take advantage of our sponsored clubs and organizations' activities; check out the recreational equipment for loan. If the need arises, inquire about Emergency Assistance, Medical Dental or Death in the Family loans. Ask about the loan of medical equipment for short term issues or a grant of items your insurance won't cover. Don't forget to tell your coworkers about the Association and feel free to call or drop by the office on A-level of the John Ferraro Building to ask questions.

<b>MEDICAL / DENTAL LOANS</b>	Is an interest-free, no cost, and automatically payroll deducted loan for medical and dental procedures not covered by your health plan.
<b>DEATH-IN-FAMILY LOANS</b>	Are interest-free, no cost loans, automatically payroll deducted to cover funeral related expenses.
<b>EMERGENCY LOANS</b>	For unforeseen financial hardships, these are automatically payroll deducted interest-free, no cost emergency loans.
<b>SAFETY SHOE LOANS &amp; EQUIPMENT</b>	Provides a discount from one of our approved vendors and allows repayment with an interest-free, no cost, and automatically payroll deducted loan. Obtain your supervisor's approval using the form on the opposite page.
<b>DISABILITY ADVANCES</b>	When disability checks are delayed due to late medical certification or processing requirements, we provide an early advance of up to 80% of the amount of your disability check.
<b>DOWNED WORKERS PROGRAM</b>	Our newest program assists family members of an employee that requires hospitalization after sustaining work related injuries. It allows a spouse or loved one to stay near the hospital by providing lodging and meal assistance

All active LADWP employees who have completed probation, or any LADWP retiree

Founded in 1978 and now reaching 4,300 women per year, the Downtown Women's Center (DWC) is the only organization in Los Angeles exclusively dedicated to addressing the immediate and long-term needs of women overcoming poverty and homelessness on downtown's Skid Row.

### HOUSING

DWC provides 119 on-site apartments, offering permanent supportive housing and a compassionate environment to women who have experienced chronic homelessness. Permanent supportive housing is affordable housing without time limits that also links residents to on-site services that contribute to personal stability and well-being.

### HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

Our Women's Health Center is an on-site clinic jointly run with local partner JWCH, through which we provide basic medical care, mammogram and HIV screenings, and physical and mental health assessments. DWC staff focuses on preventive care to reduce diabetes, obesity, hypertension, and other chronic diseases. We supplement our clinic offerings with mental health counseling, as well as fitness classes, self-care, and health education workshops.

### DAY CENTER

For women living on the streets or in night-to-night shelters, our drop-in Day Center provides a respite from the rigors of the street while also providing home-cooked meals, clean clothing, showers, referrals to housing and other services. The Day Center is a place of community, where women listen, talk, and support each other.

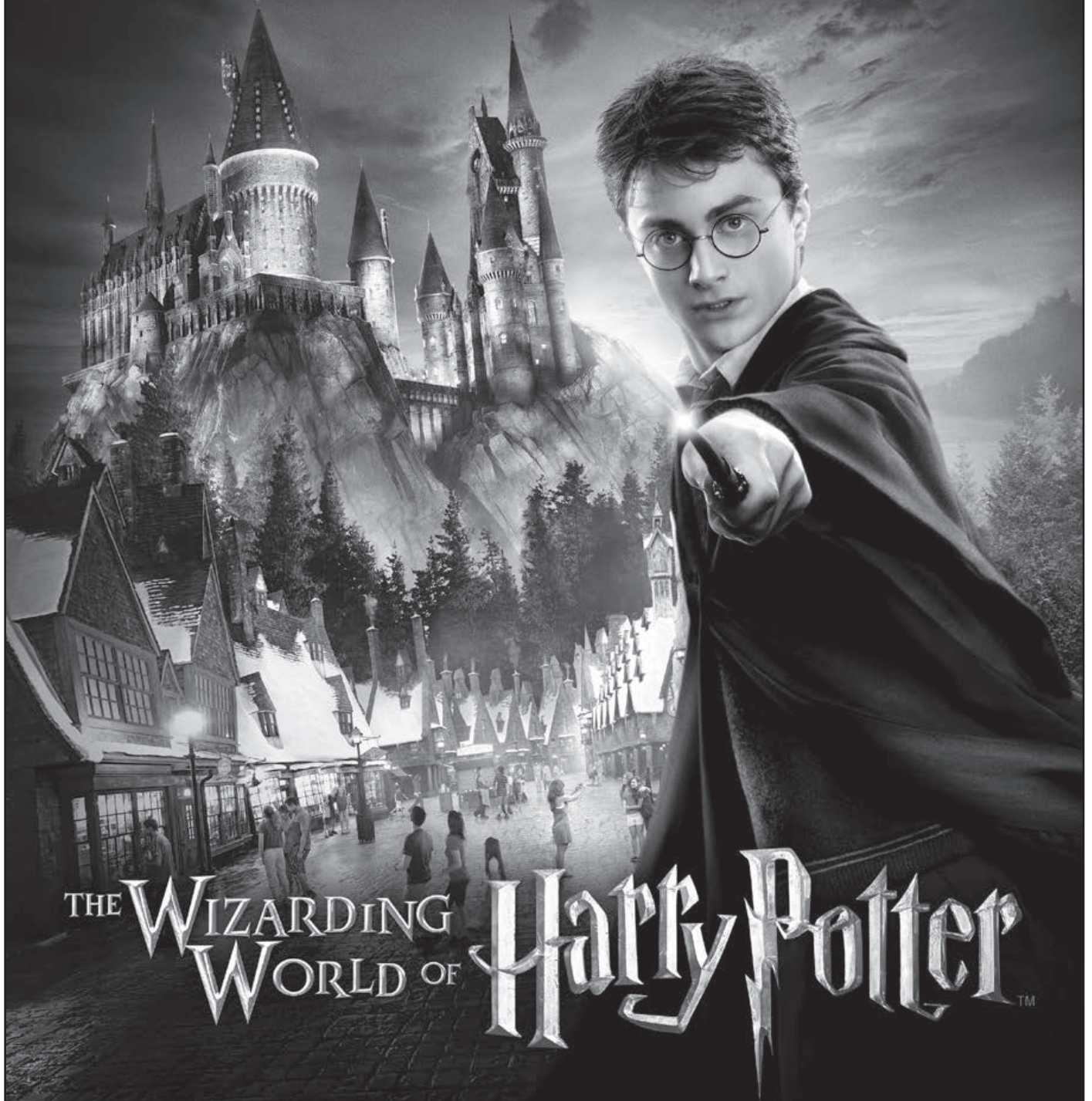

To be eligible for a \$5,000 membership, the **spouse** must be 49 years or younger.

- Employees cannot apply for this benefit after 59 years of age.
- Spouses cannot apply for this benefit after 49 years of age.
- All benefits are based on the employees' active membership to the Mutual Benefit Plan.
- The committee has final discretion in accepting applications.
- Application must be submitted 30 days before qualifying birthdate.
