



INTERVIEW WITH JAIME ALMARAZ

Congratulations to Jaime Almaraz for running 100K in the famous Kodiak Big Bear trail race. Awesome Job!

Total miles run: 72 miles and total time: Official Time 16:56:52, 12th place. The race was actually only 100k/63 miles, however, He missed some trail markers and went off course. He had to run extra miles to get back on course and finish.

When did you become DWP family? I became DWP family in February 30, 2013.

How long you have been running? I grew up playing soccer, but I didn't run just to run until 2017. I worked in the Power System UG Structures Group at the time, which had a great camaraderie among the runners Oscar Rodriguez / Thomas Enriquez / Edgar Mercado / Oscar Estrada / Yohannes Nigusie. They convinced me to sign up for the October 2017 Rock 'n' Roll Half Marathon in DTLA. I ran that race and was hooked.

How do you prepare for the race? I put together a rough training plan that I follow as best I can. I have two kids and one on the way. I don't want running to impact my family time, so that means a lot of early morning runs.

What made you compete in the ultra run race? I set the 100k distance goal after my last race. Since then Covid restrictions had cancelled most races, until recently. In June 2021 they announced the Big Bear 100k, and I decided to give it a shot.

What other races you have participated?

Yes, I have run:

- May 2019 – 50k
- August 2019 – 50 Miler
- January 2020 – 50 Miler
- August 2021 – 100k

Do you think the 100 miles will be a piece of cake? Running longer races changes your perspective on the mileage, but it doesn't make the running any easier. You still have to endure.




